

Occupation Group Listing

Occupation Group	Description
Group 1	Managerial, administrative, sedentary, office based or profession in specific business or services. e.g. doctor, accountant, lawyer, administrator, office or clerical worker.
Group 2	Sales or light manual work: Your job involves light manual duties or local travel (but not delivering goods) e.g. waiter/waitress, sales, retail shop worker, nurse, cleaner, factory supervisor with light duties, engineer or other professional who do occasional fieldwork.
Group 3	Manual work but no heavy labour: Your job involves manual labour but requires no heavy lifting, you work mostly indoors and may require a trade certificate. e.g. cook, plumber, construction supervisor, driver, gardener or police.
Group 4	Heavy manual labour with or without specialized training: Your job involves heavy manual labour with some heavy lifting, you may not need specialized training for your work e.g. mechanic, construction worker (but not at heights), builder, factory worker, labourer or security guard.
Group 5	Risky occupations: Your job involves any of the following: working to 15 meters or more, working underwater or underground, shipping, offshore work or fishing, mining, oil rigs, armed services, coast guard, working with chemicals or explosives, professional sports or non-commercial pilot.
Group 6	Not in paid employment: You are not in paid employment e.g. Housewife, Homemaker, Student, Retiree or not currently employed.
